



Nine CERT Sizeup Steps

Sgt. Chris Shenk informed how the CERT Situational Awareness steps can be combined with the Situational Awareness that Law Enforcement practices to create a more robust awareness level.

- 1. Identify Objects Around You
- 2. Notice Other People
- 3. Identify Entry and Exit Points
- 4. Practice Prediction
- 5. Stay Vigilant
- 6. Trust Yourself
- 7. Practice Situational "CERT" Techniques

- 1.Gather facts.
- 2. Assess and communicate the damage.
- 3. Consider probabilities.
- 4. Assess your own situation.
- 5.Establish priorities.
- 6.Make decisions.
- 7. Develop a plan of action.
- 8.Take action.

Cold Impacts & Preparedness



Potential Impacts

- Frozen pipes could become a significant problem.
- Dead car batteries could strand people.
- Any power outages that occur (weather related or not) could leave people without heat.
- People may improperly use secondary sources of heat; increasing chances for Carbon Monoxide poisoning.
- Structure fires could escalate.
- Frostbite/hypothermia.
- Ice jams could become a problem.

Safety Tips

- Stay indoors during the worst part of the extreme cold.
- Keep a winter survival kit in your vehicle if you must travel.
- Check tire pressure, antifreeze levels, heater/defroster, etc.
- Learn how to shut off water valves for potential pipe bursts.
- Trickle water through their pipes and to increase heating in crawl/ceiling spaces to prevent freezing in the first place.
- ✓ Check on the elderly.
- ✓ Bring pets inside.

Rich and David presented how the environment effects a person and how to mitigate those effects.

How to Dress

- Wear layers of loose-fitting, lightweight clothing.
- Wear a hat as 40% of your body heat can be lost from your head.
- Cover your mouth to protect your lungs from extreme cold.
- Mittens, snug at the wrist, are better than gloves.
- Try to stay dry and out of the wind.

We are pleased to announce in coordination with the CERT Association of Illinois the next CERT Train-the-Trainer course.

It will be held on **June 10-11 at the Aurora Emergency Operations Center** with all appropriate COVID-19 precautions that are in place at that time. Please see below for further details.

Course Length: 14 hours

Course Timeline: Day 1: 8:00 am to 3:30 pm; Day 2: 8:00 am to 3:00 pm.

<u>Prior to course registration</u>, the following items need to be submitted to Michelle Hanneken at <u>michelle.hanneken@illinois.gov</u>

- 1. Letter/email from unit of government or organization sponsoring the CERT program verifying that the attendee will be instructing this course on behalf of the organization in the future.
- 2. Attendee will submit a certificate of local CERT class participation, verifying that the 20-hour course has already been completed. In limited circumstances, the FEMA Independent Study (IS) 317 class can substitute for this; however, that should be explained in the letter above why the local class has not been attended. This exception must be pre-approved.

In addition, it is suggested that the FEMA IS 242.b Effective Communications online course might be of value to those attending the CERT train-the-trainer program but it is not required.

Once these items are received, the attendee will be notified as having met the prerequisites and will be directed to register for the course in the IEMA registration portal at https://public.iema.state.il.us/iema/Training/OnlineReg/Login.asp

Our intent is to provide the CERT T-t-T course once per quarter. For your future planning purposes, we are still planning to try to provide the quarter 3 course in Springfield in conjunction with the IEMA conference and a late fall course in Chicago.






